Equally as impressive are the well-stocked pantry and cellar, and the fridge laden with Helen's delicious meals. An exceptional cook, Helen has been producing gourmet delights under her Angaston Appetizers label since 2003 and puts a strong focus on fresh, seasonal food that showcases the Barossa's finest produce. If you feel like taking a break from the kitchen during your stay, with a little notice Helen can conjure up morning tea, lunch, antipasti or dinner!

Along with booking in for a class with Jacqueline, guests are free to take scenic walks around the extensive property, pick fruit from the Jellicoe orchard and catch yabbies in the onsite dam. Personal tastings of Sorby Adams wines can be arranged with Simon, and the Barossa's countless attractions are all in close proximity.

It's clear that Simon and Helen have thought of absolutely everything to ensure all visits to Jellicoe House are out of the ordinary. Wedding packages are also available and can be tailored to suit individual needs.
