WINEMAKER'S NOTES

GI: Williamstown, Eden Valley.

Colour: Bright straw with subtle green-grey hues. **Aroma:** Delicate aromas of citrus blossom, jasmine and fresh nashi pear, complemented by hints of green apple and white florals. **Palate:** Crisp and refreshing, showcasing vibrant pear and citrus flavours with a fine texture and graceful balance. Natural acidity carries the wine through to a clean, persistent finish. Serve chilled to enjoy its refreshment.

Cellar: Drink now to 2028.
