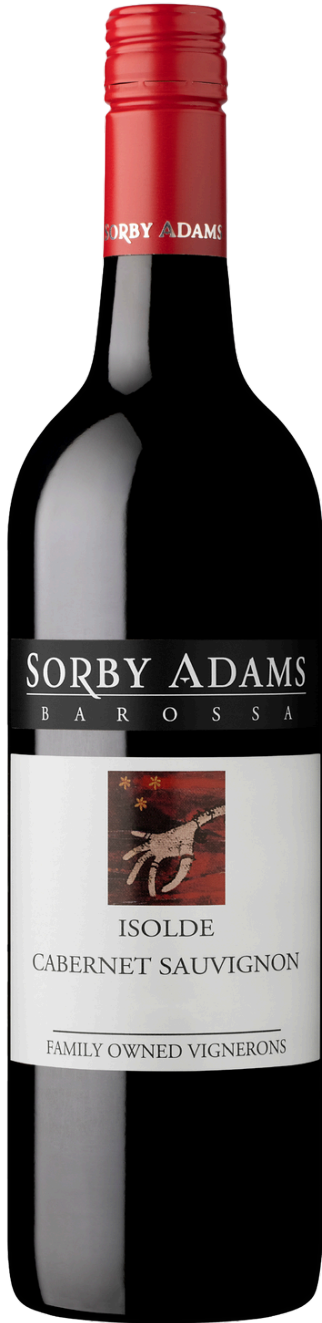

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Fruit characters of blackberry, cassis and blackcurrant, with higher tones of redcurrant and red cherry showing through. Hints of red liquorice, cinnamon, five-spice, briar, earth, espresso and chocolate combine to produce a most alluring and complex bouquet.

Cellar – At its best now and up to 2027.

Fruit – Cabernet Sauvignon from the Barossa.
