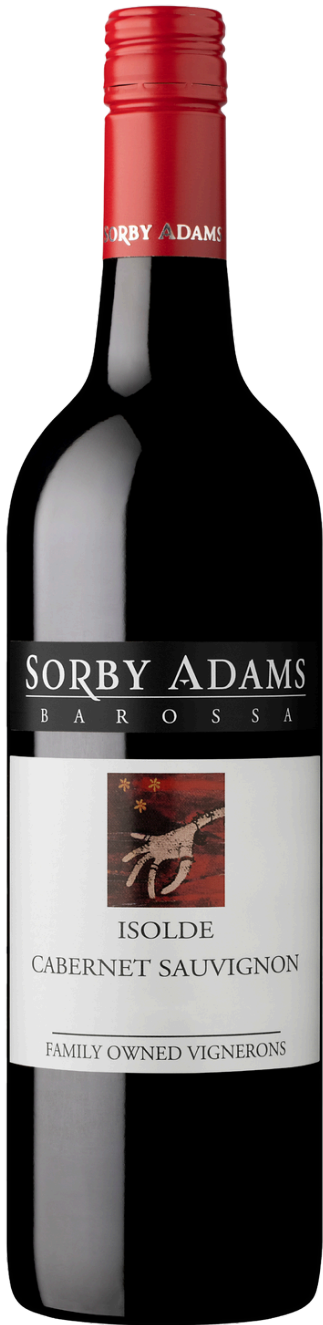

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Colour: Rich scarlet red.

Aroma: Heady scent of dark fruit, smoked game, dried cherry, and toasted nut.

Palate: Silky polish tannins and gorgeous fruit flavours. An elegant wine.

Cellar: At its best now and up to 2030.

Fruit: Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from the Barossa.
