Colour - Deep ruby with brick edge. **Aroma** - Fragrant wild strawberry and cranberry flavours with a hint of orange zest. **Palate** - Fragrant berries continue on the palate with a creamy finish. **Oak** - Matured in French oak hogsheads (30% new) for 18 months. 4 year air dried, Francois Frere and Taransaud Coopers. **Cellar** - Drink now to 2033. Sealed with QORK. **Fruit** - Old vine grenache from the Barossa (Riebke vineyard, est. 130 year old vines)
