The Barossa is Australia's most famous wine region. Thankfully, it has also been my home since 1980 where I am fortunate to be amongst an amazing group of people – winemakers, vigneron, and of course friends.

Claudius Ptolemy, a 2nd-century Greek mathematician and astronomer, proposed the geocentric theory that placed Earth at the universe's centre, influencing astronomy for over a thousand years.

Our Sorby Adams wine label honours mathematician and astronomer, John Couch Adams F.R.S, an ancestor of Simon Sorby Adams, who mathematically proved Neptune's existence.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

GI: South West Eden Valley, single vineyard (450m) **Colour:** Bright red with purple tints. **Aroma:** Vibrant berry, red cherry and plum, with a hint of spice. **Palate:** Balanced acidity and silky smooth tannins linger with subtle notes of French oak in this medium-bodied wine. **Oak:** French (10% new) for 12 months. 4 year air-dried, fine-grained. Francois Frere and Taransaud Coopers.

Cellar: Drink now to 2030.
